Bring your instruments:

Students are required to bring their own instruments for the entire program as we are unable to lend out instruments. We also highly recommend that you come with your own instruments instead of trying to rent through music stores as it may be difficult to reserve instruments. Students should plan to bring instruments for the first day as you will need them in the afternoon. Here are some special notes regarding specific instruments:

- **Guitar, bass woodwinds/brass, strings:** instruments, bass players can bring electric (double bass not required)
- **Piano:** only keyboards needed for practicing off-campus
- **Drummers:** sticks, cymbals, practice pads, and hi-hat clutch
- **Vocalists:** Microphones and cables
